## Church of St. Andrew Overview of Confirmation Preparation Course Summary Statement

Young people discerning to celebrate Confirmation first begin by reflecting upon their Catholic identity and how this may be either tribal, selective, or a sense of both. During the fall and early winter candidates will discover what being a Catholic Christian disciple means to others and how they live this out in their daily lives through a variety of presentations and discussions. These include Deacon Fred sharing about Social Justice and our call to help those less fortunate than us, members of the Respect Life Committee talking about their passion for protecting all life from Womb to Tomb, Jim Schroeder's discusses why the Eucharist is the source and summit of his life, Michelle Steele challenges young people to consider their dating practices and how these will help or deter their potential marriage, Stephan Cizmowski passionately shares with young people his life as missionary in Mexico while inviting the candidates to join him on a mission trip their senior year, Brian Jorgensen shares what it means to be Catholic to him in a world surrounded by other Christian denominations and faiths, and finally Fr. Mark has a conversation with young people about his hopes and dreams for the Confirmation journey and the need to witness, show, and share their faith in their everyday lives.

In early December all Confirmation candidates participate in an intensified twilight retreat hosted by the National Evangelization Team (NET). These dynamic young adults share why their faith is so important to them that they volunteer to serve God and Church by traveling to different parishes and providing retreat experiences. Many young people share that this is the highlight of their Confirmation preparation!

The second half of the year begins with a large group presentation engaging the young people on how past Early Church Christian Initiation is lived out through today's practice of late adolescent Confirmation in our diocese; the value of Eucharist as the most important Church Sacrament will be stressed.

Final preparation for Confirmation involves a series of large group presentations on topics mandated by the St. Cloud Diocese including the connection between Baptism and Confirmation, Gifts of the Holy Spirit, the theology and liturgy of Confirmation, and then the life of Christian Discipleship after Confirmation.

Throughout the year of preparation young people are expected to meet with their Confirmation sponsor, an active practicing Catholic adult, and discuss various Catholic Christian topics contained in a Candidate/Sponsor booklet provided by the St. Cloud Diocese.
