

St. Andrew Cemetery complies with the Minnesota Catholic Cemetery Rules and Regulations and General Rules of the St. Andrews Cemetery as stated below.

### **St. Andrew Cemetery General Rules**

- One plant stand is permitted per grave site and must be at least 16 inches off the ground with no other adornments.
- No trees or shrubs may be planted.
- Flowers in a plant stand are permitted from May 1st through October 1st.
- Flags may be put on a grave one week before Memorial Day and are to be picked up one week after.
- Christmas wreaths are allowed from December 1st through April 1st.
- April is spring clean up, all materials in pot stands will be removed and disposed of.
- The cemetery will remove all items which are contrary to the regulations and is not responsible for them. All items not removed will be placed inside or behind the garage, depending on the item. The name on the grave stone or monument will be placed on the item removed.
- All plastic or live flowers placed directly into the ground or on a grave marker are not allowed.
- All decorations are **prohibited** unless they are specifically permitted under the rules and regulations.
- The list of prohibited decorations includes, but is not limited to, vigil or solar lights, pictures, boxes, shells, toys, shepherd's hooks, or similar hanging devices, discarded glassware, sprinkling cans, receptacles, or similar articles. These are not permitted on any grave, lot or tree.
- Visitors may not throw or scatter papers or other material on cemetery grounds.
